(Each Darshan visit is allowed for less than 10 minutes only)

Temple Open Timings:

Thursday : 06:00 PM to 09.00 PM

**Saturday/Sunday : 10:00 AM to 12:30 Noon
06:00 PM to 9.00 PM**

1. We request every devotee to follow all published guidelines and do not visit the temple if you are sick, not feeling well or recently travelled to/from other countries/hotspots
2. All devotees entering the Temple **MUST** wear Facemask and it is mandatory. No Facemask - No admittance. (We have Facemasks to sell you. But we recommend bringing your own Facemask. Everyone 2 years and older must wear Facemask).
3. We strongly advise (per CDC guidelines), that you maintain Social-Distance of **AT LEAST 6 feet** between people. Follow the signs and directions as posted.
4. We will admit only a limited number of devotees for a limited time during your visit. Please wait in your car and wait outside as directed by the volunteer

- 5. While inside the Temple, singing and loud recitals are not allowed (only silent prayers).**
- 6. We will have the right to check your body temperature. We urge you to check your body temperature at home and if anyone with higher than normal body temperature, dry cough, cold or fever is urged not to enter the temple premises.**
- 7. You will not get Theertham, SaTaari or Prasadam during this Health Emergency.**
- 8. We provide sanitizers in the temple and urge everyone to use these sanitizers.**
- 9. We request Devotees are urged not to touch anything at the Temple.**
- 10. We accept no outside supplies including rice, nuts, flowers, oil etc. Please do not bring any supplies to Temple.**
- 11. We request to leave the footwear outside in the area marked in the temple**
- 12. We are not allowing anyone to the Meditation hall**
- 13. Restrooms access is not allowed as per public authority's guidance**
- 14. No drinking water and Kitchen area access inside the temple premises.**
- 15. The temple visit will be allowed only on appointments/signup done through the website. All registration must include name, number of devotees in the group, a valid contact phone number, email. We also will keep a manual register to make sure to note the devotees visiting the temple (For contact tracing purpose)**
- 16. Water fountains will not be operational based on public authority's guidance**
- 17. Temple accepts no liability with your visit.**
- 18. Temple reserves the right to modify any of these guidelines without notice.**
- 19. Devotees are requested to comply and cooperate with the staff and volunteers by following these guidelines**
- 20. We continue to stream all the Puja's / Arathis online. Devotees can check our temple website and see the Arathis.**
